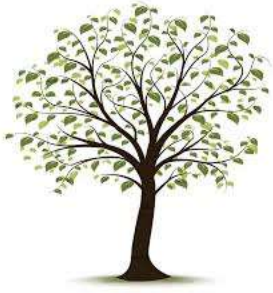

In the Agricultural Schedule of 1851 for Berthier County, Québec, Albert resided on a 95-acre (112 arpens) farm in Isle du Pas, Berthier Co., Québec. Of this total, 87 acres were under cultivation with the other 8.5 being either wooded or uncultivated. Of the 87 cultivated acres, 67 produced a crop in 1851 while the other 20 were in pasture. Livestock consisted of 6 dairy cows, 1 bull, oxen or steers, 13 calves and heifers, 3 horses, 10 sheep and 7 pigs. In 1851 the farm produced 66 bushels of wheat on 6.75 acres, 55 bushels of peas on 3.0 acres, 750 bushels of oats on 32 acres, 50 bushels of buckwheat on 2.5 acres, 16 bushels of corn on 0.2 acres, 66 bushels of potatoes on 0.4 acres, 200 bushels of turnips on 0.2 acres, 5 bushels of clover, millet and other fodders, 25 bushels of carrots, 220 (?) of mangels and 6000 "bundles" of hay. The farm also produced 300 lbs. of butter, 48 lbs. of cheese, 258 barrels of beef, 1100 barrels of pork, 50 lbs. of wool, 4 lbs. of flax seed, 31-1/4 yds. of "fulled cloth", 90 yds. of "cloth" and 28-3/4 yds. of "flannel". Under "Observations" it is recorded that of the 95 acres farmed, 25 acres were located in Berthier (now Berthierville).
