* Herman was employed as a volunteer in 1717; became prime minister 1718; clan 1742 31/3; Lieutenant 17432 21/9; Captain 1753 25/10. He had 52 years of service in 1769 when he was still in service. He was as a nineteen-year-old in the campaign against Norway, where he himself writes: "... 1718, when I (hardest words) in August followed with the army to Norway, from where I came home without harm".
