Student in Uppsala 1621 27/2. After a few years of study, he went to Johan Banér's army and won employment in the fortification. In the dragoons in 1638; captain there. In 1639, worked as city engineer at the Kristianspris fortress (Fredriksort) in Holstein 1644 1/1; commanded at the siege of Rendsburg in Aug. 1645; was in the army until 1646 when he was granted leave home; at the battle at Viborg's castle in 1648 31/7. Resigned from the palace chief executive in 1652 13/8; then settled at his inherited home in Lingared; he died there in 1678 close to his family. His and his wife's portraits are in Hudiksvall's educational museum.
