Notes:

*Bryngel (Bryniel) was born in Torsåker probably in the 1570s. From 1598, he used his father's home in Ed and Hammar in Ytterlännäs. In 1602, he was the County Governor. In 1603, he was fined 40 ? for "homeland" (home break-in). In 1607-1608, his hometown burned in Hammar. In the same year, he got fined six ? because he beat Johannes Wik in the head. In 1608, he paid one of the highest tenants rent in Ångermanland. In 1612, he married Christina Persdotter. In 1613, he was Länsman and had 54 *seland* free from tax. In the same year, he was sentenced to life for adultery with his leggy, Ingel. He had been a newlywed for a year. However, he was pardoned at the request of his wife, but was fined 20 dollars. Later, he became Master of Interest in Gävle, where he died on March 28, 1641.

**John Petri was an Associate Professor in Strängnäs in 1596. Promoted to file. magistrate in Wittenberg in 1600. Theology Associate Professor in Strängnäs in 1604. Principal of King Karl IX in 1605. Appointed to Theology Professor in Uppsala in 1605 and was Pastor in Umeå from 1609-1612.

***Sigfrid Petri studied at Uppsala from 1595-1602 in Rostock Field; priest in Riga in 1630. Probably died as Magistrate.
